Competitor's Information and Syllabus

The term 'Pro-Am' is defined as a Professional teacher dancing with their student. A Student Dancer does not teach Ballroom, Latin, Smooth or Rhythm.

The term 'Teacher/Student' is defined as an Amateur or Professional teacher dancing with their student. A Student Dancer does not teach Ballroom, Latin, Smooth or Rhythm.

An Amateur or Professional teacher may only have one Student Dancer in any given competition. Strictly no partner changes in any event.

Age Groups & Categories

Juvenile & Junior:

A – U8 B – U10 C – U12 D – U14 E – U16

U8 – Born on or after 28/03/2014, U10 – Born on or after 28/03/2012

U12 – Born on or after 28/03/2010, U14 – Born on or after 28/03/2008

U16 – Born on or after 28/03/2006

U8s may dance in U10s & U12s. U10s may dance in U12s. U14s may dance in U16s
EXCEPT SINGLE DANCE EVENTS – please see entry sheet

Proof of age may be requested.

All Juvenile events are restricted syllabus & dress as per BDC rule book.

All Junior events are open syllabus & dress.

Adult:

A1 – U40 restricted syllabus

A2 – U40 unrestricted syllabus

B1 – 40 & Over restricted syllabus

B2 – 40 & Over unrestricted syllabus

C1 – 60 & Over restricted syllabus

C2 – 60 & Over unrestricted syllabus

Age division is determined by the Student Dancer – proof of age may be requested.

Student Dancers may dance ONE age group lower than their actual age division.

No dress restrictions in any adult events.

A Student Dancer may dance with an Amateur or Professional partner of the same gender without fear or favour.

Competition Entry – Friday 25th March, ProAm Showdance & Britannia Open Professional Events

Entry to the ProAm Showdance & Britannia Open Professional Ballroom/Latin American competitions include unreserved seating at our Welcome Party. Limited evening rover tickets will be available closer to the date.

Competition Entry – Saturday 26th March, WDO World Senior Latin, ProAm & Amateur Ballroom

All dancers, teachers and spectators must purchase an admission ticket for the daytime sessions. WDO Senior Latin competitors that do not qualify for the Grand Finals on Saturday evening have evening unreserved seating included. Unreserved seating is included for Amateur Ballroom competitors with their entry. Limited evening rover tickets will be available closer to the date.

Competition Entry – Sunday 27th March, Teacher Student & Britannia Open Titles

All Juvenile & Junior admission tickets include entry to the Single Dance events in ONE age group only. All Britannia Open competitor's entry fee includes admission.

All spectators & teachers must purchase an admission ticket.

Entry fees up until the 28th February are listed below. After this date prices will increase. Entries close 11th March 2022. Late entries may be accepted by the organisers at their discretion. All entries will be confirmed via email to the address supplied. Please bring a copy of this confirmation with you to the event.

Entry fees must be made in advance direct to the organisers. Entries will only be confirmed once full payment has been made. Payment can be made via bank transfer, Sterling or cheque from a UK bank account. Alternatively, entry and payment can be made via our secure online portal.
